



ISC - APPROPRIATENESS TO SPEECH PURPOSE AND AUDIENCE

THINGS TO CONSIDER - DO'S

- Purpose The speech should be drafted keeping the purpose and the audience in perspective
 - Different types of Speech Purpose Informative, Persuasive, Entertaining, Inspirational
- - Language Usage– The language should be simple, authentic, and convincing and should be used to bring in variety, imagery, and rhythm through words. Use triads and metaphors to make the speech powerful.
 - Sentence Formation The speech should have a variety of short and long sentences to bring in the engaging style
 - Conversational Style The speech should have a blend of dialogues, narrations, and questions to bring characters to live, keep the speech interactive and allow scope for voice modulations
- - Message The message should be crafted using simple language which can be relatable to the audience





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THINGS TO AVOID - DON'TS

- Avoid using jargon in the speech
- Don't use words to differentiate groups of people that might hurt emotions
- Avoid extremely short sentences to not sound choppy
