


UNDERSTANDING YOUR LEADERSHIP STYLE

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this project is for the member to identify their primary leadership style or styles. The purpose of this speech is for the member to share some aspect of their primary leadership style or discuss leadership styles in general.

OVERVIEW

The member must complete the Discover Your Leadership Style questionnaire and consider how their leadership style impacts those around them. They should also reflect on how they can adjust their style to more effectively lead people with different styles. The member must then deliver a 5- to 7-minute speech at a club meeting, sharing some aspect of their leadership style or leadership styles in general. They may choose to discuss their style preferences when working with others, how they adapt their style to different situations, or how various leadership styles impact a group.


UNDERSTANDING YOUR COMMUNICATION STYLE

They must then deliver a 5- to 7-minute speech at a club meeting about their communication style and its impact on their professional and/or personal relationships. If uncomfortable discussing their own style, the member may speak about communication styles they have encountered and how they impact them.


INTRODUCTION TO TOASTMASTERS MENTORING
