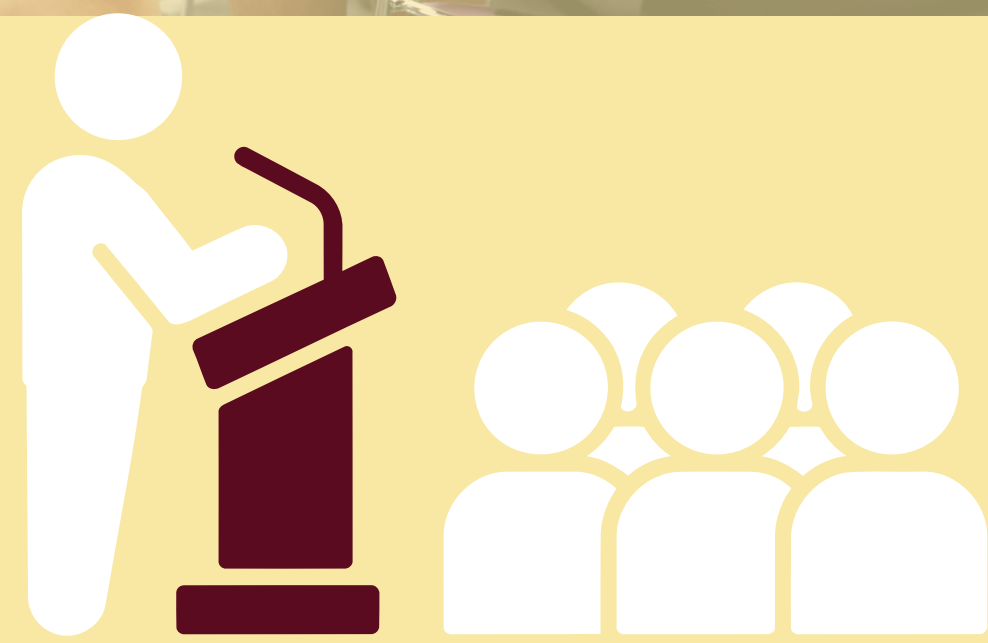
# MENTORING

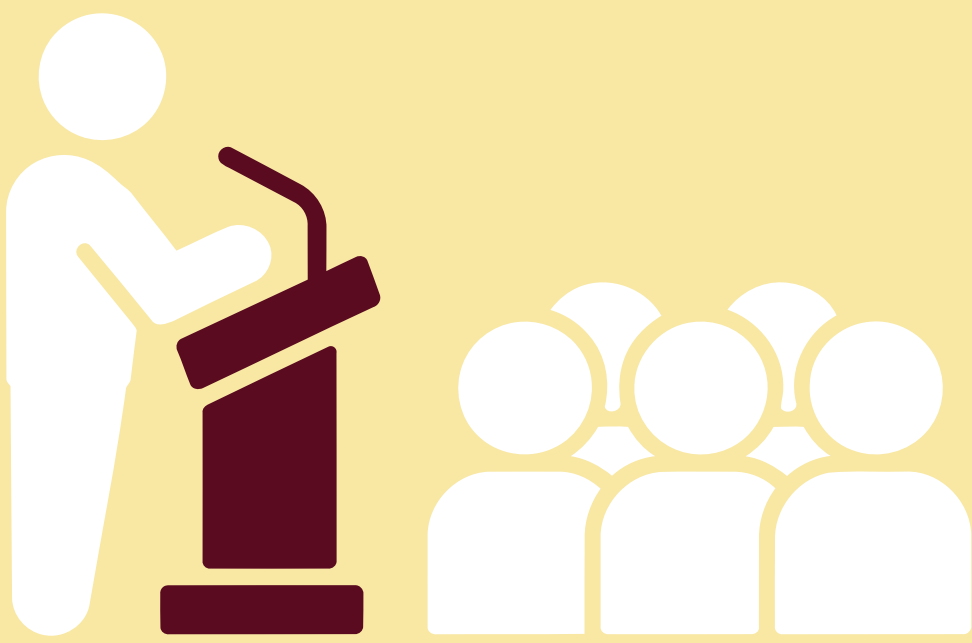
