

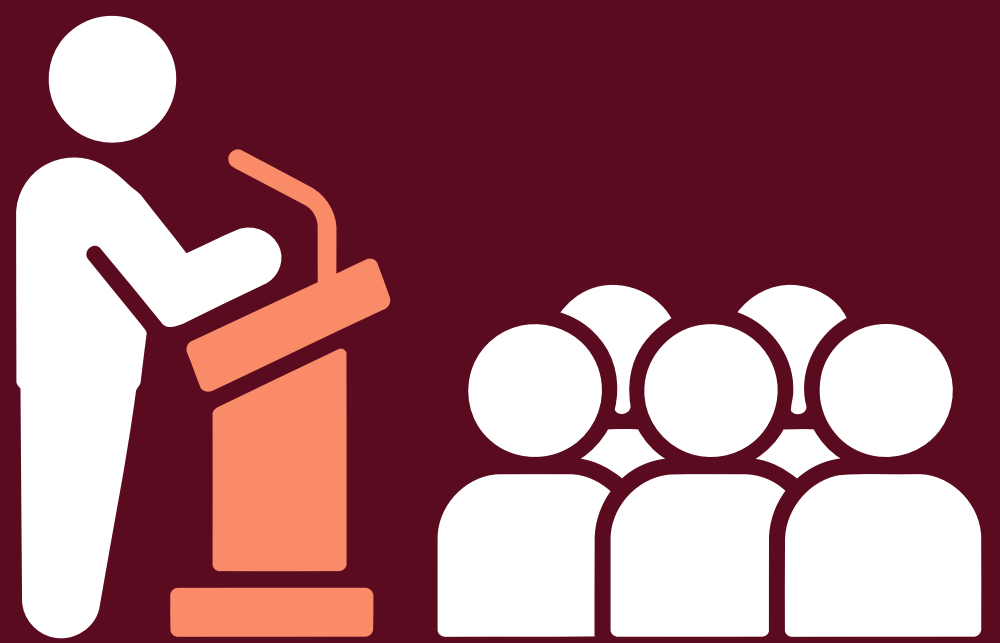
UNDERSTANDING YOUR COMMUNICATION STYLE

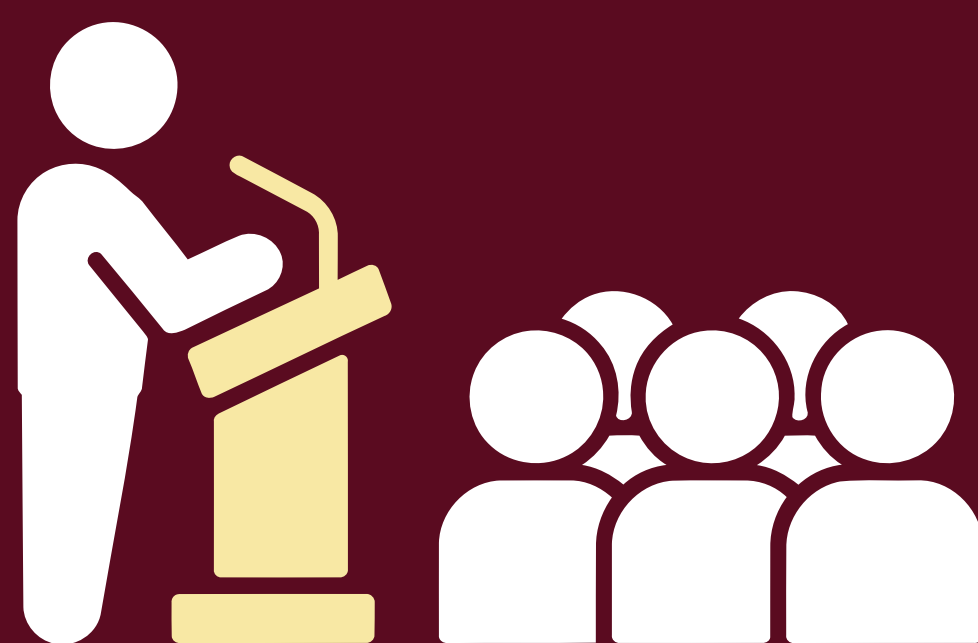
ACTIVE LISTENING

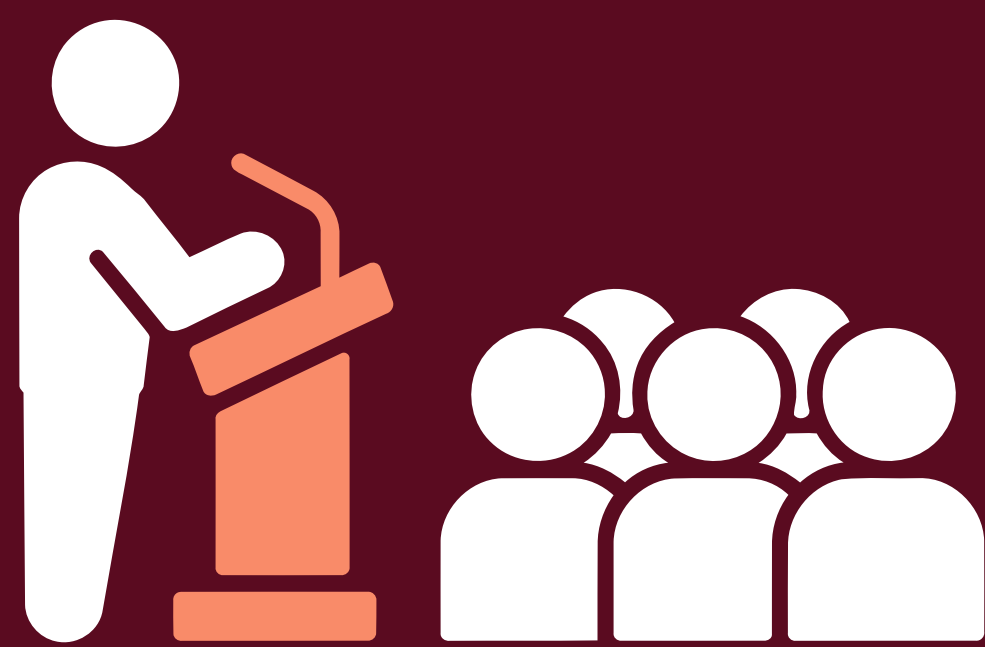
INTRODUCTION TO TOASTMASTERS MENTORING
