
TEAM BUILDING



The purpose of this project is to practice the skills needed to build a cohesive team and host an event

OVERVIEW

The member must build and work with a small team to design and host a team-building event, either within their Toastmasters club or in another approved environment. Non-Toastmasters events must be approved by the club's vice president education and attended by a member of the club leadership team. Before the event, the member must deliver a 2- to 3-minute report at a club meeting to share their plans. After the event, the member must deliver a 5- to 7-minute speech to the club about the event, the impact of leading on themselves and their team, or how building a team influenced their growth as a leader.



PROJECT INCLUDES

Working with a small team to design and host a team-building event, delivering a 2- to 3-minute report before the event, and a 5- to 7-minute speech after the event

LESSONS LEARNED

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this project is for the member to learn about and apply the skills needed to run a lessons learned meeting during a project or after its completion. The purpose of this speech is for the member to share some aspect of their leadership experience and the impact of a lessons learned meeting.

OVERVIEW

The member must select a project to complete with a team of at least three other members. The member must form a guidance committee and meet at least five times throughout the duration of the project. The member must deliver a 5 to 7 minute speech at a club meeting to introduce their plan and vision. The member must ask members of the team to complete a 360° evaluation of their leadership skills. After implementing the plan, the member must deliver a second 5 to 7 minute speech at a club meeting to share their experience developing and completing the plan.

PROJECT INCLUDES

Selecting, leading, and completing a project with a team; sharing the 360° Evaluation with members; and delivering two 5 to 7 minute speeches.

MODERATE A PANEL DISCUSSION

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this project is to apply your skills as a public speaker and leader to facilitate a panel discussion.

OVERVIEW

The member must plan and moderate a 20- to 40-minute panel discussion on any topic, organizing at least three panelists. Panelists do not receive Pathways credit. When possible, the member should volunteer as a panelist for another member's project.



PROJECT INCLUDES

Planning and moderating a 20- to 40-minute panel discussion

ETHICAL LEADERSHIP

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this project is for the member to develop a clear understanding of their ethical framework and create an opportunity for others to hear about and discuss ethics in the member's organization or community.

OVERVIEW

The member must define a personal ethical framework, which may require additional research. They must then organize and moderate a 20- to 40-minute panel discussion on ethics—within an organization or community—followed by a Q&A session. The panel must include at least three members, with one from outside Toastmasters.



PROJECT INCLUDES

A 20 to 40 minute panel discussion with Question & Answer Session

HIGH PERFORMANCE LEADERSHIP

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of this project is to apply your leadership and planning knowledge to develop a project plan, organize a guidance committee, and implement your plan with the help of a team.

OVERVIEW

The member must choose a project to complete with a team of at least three other members. They must form a guidance committee and meet at least five times throughout the project. The member must deliver a 5 to 7 minute speech at a club meeting to present their plan and vision. The member must ask members of the team to complete a 360° evaluation of their leadership skills. After executing the plan, the member must deliver a second 5 to 7 minute speech to share their experience in developing and completing the project.

PROJECT INCLUDES

Selecting, leading, and completing a project with a team; forming and meeting with a guidance committee at least five times; sharing the 360° Evaluation resource with members; and delivering two 5 to 7 minute speeches.

The purpose of this project is for the member to apply the skills needed to successfully lead in a volunteer organization. The purpose of this speech is for the member to share some aspect of their experience serving as a leader in a volunteer organization

OVERVIEW

The member must serve in a leadership role in Toastmasters or another volunteer organization for at least six months. While this project may be based on the member's employment, a volunteer organization is preferred. The member must ask members of the organization to complete a 360° evaluation of their leadership skills. They must also create a succession plan to support the transition after leaving the leadership role. After completing the six-month term, the member must deliver a 5 to 7 minute speech at a club meeting to reflect on their personal experience.

PROJECT INCLUDES

Serving in a volunteer leadership role for a minimum of six months, conducting a 360° evaluation of your leadership skills, creating a succession plan, and delivering a 5 to 7 minute speech.


PREPARE TO SPEAK PROFESSIONALLY
